Green Collar Jobs

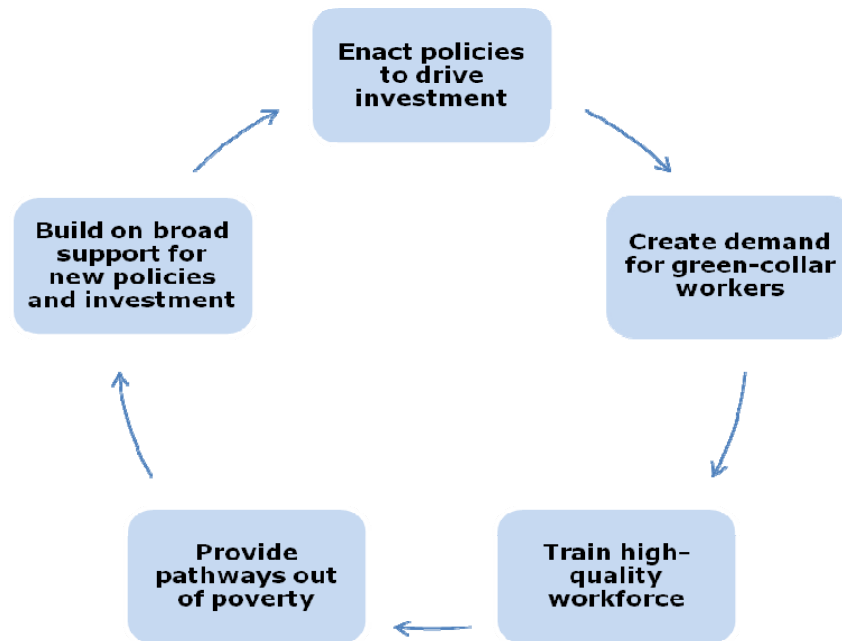
Well-paid, career track jobs that contribute directly to enhancing environmental quality. Help create sustainable local economies.

Definition has expanded to anyone working in environmentally-oriented, renewable industries.

Green Jobs Throughout the Economy

- In 2006, U.S. renewable energy and energy efficiency industries generated 8.5 million new direct and indirect jobs, \$971 billion in industry revenue, and \$150 billion in increased federal, state, and local government tax revenues.
- Wind, solar, biomass, hydrogen fuel cells, green building, and energy efficiency products.
- It means building a sustainable economy, where environmental goals go hand in hand with social and economic goals.

Federal Action

- Green Jobs Act of 2007 – authorized \$125 Million w.in Energy Ind & Security Act (amends workforce investment act of 1998)
- Funding to be increased to \$250 M (Green Jobs & Infrastructure Act)
- Train 70,000 workers in 1st year
 - Job training/Retraining
 - Entry level and advanced skills

Green Recovery Stimulus

2.5 Million Jobs in Two Yrs



- \$100 B Package
- \$25 B – Jobs/Growth Fund (Fix it First Infrastructure)
- Advanced Manuf Supports (hybrids, plug-ins, clean e)
- \$2 B - public transit
- \$5 B in renewable-energy bonds
- \$2.5 B to buy and scrap old polluting cars
- \$900 M to help weatherize a million homes.

Greening the Stimulus Package

- 2.5 Million jobs in two years
- \$15 B per year over ten tears
- Energy Efficiency – Smart Bldg Loan Fund, Block Grants, Smart Grid,
- ‘Shovel ready Projects’ vs ‘Environmentally Sustainable Projects’
